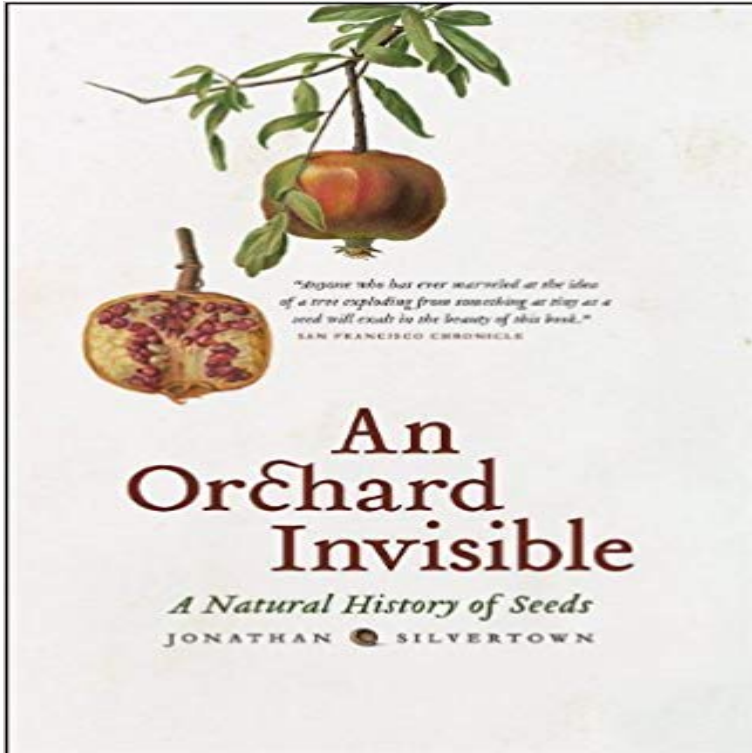


An Orchard Invisible: A Natural History of Seeds
