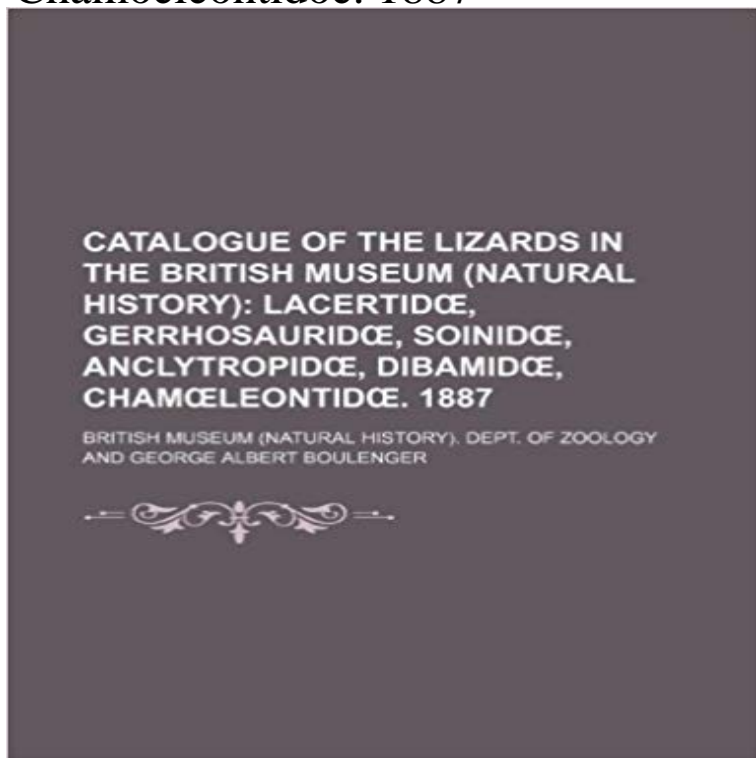

Ear-opening roundish or oval, not or scarcely larger than the transparent palpebral disk, with two or three short obtuse lobules anteriorly. 24 to 26 scales round the middle of the body, all smooth; dorsals largest, especially the two vertebral series, laterals smallest. Marginal praeanales not or very slightly enlarged. The hind limb reaches the elbow or the axilla. Digits moderately elongate, flattened except at the end, which is strongly compressed; Subdigital lamellae very fine, smooth, 70 to 90 under the fourth toe. Tail about twice as long as head and body, often a little over. Bronzy olive or brown above, uniform or with small darker and lighter spots; frequently a black lateral band, commencing from the nostril, passing through the eye, and lost on the side of the body; this band usually bordered above and below by a series of whitish spots; lower surfaces usually bluish green, sometimes yellowish. millim. millim.
