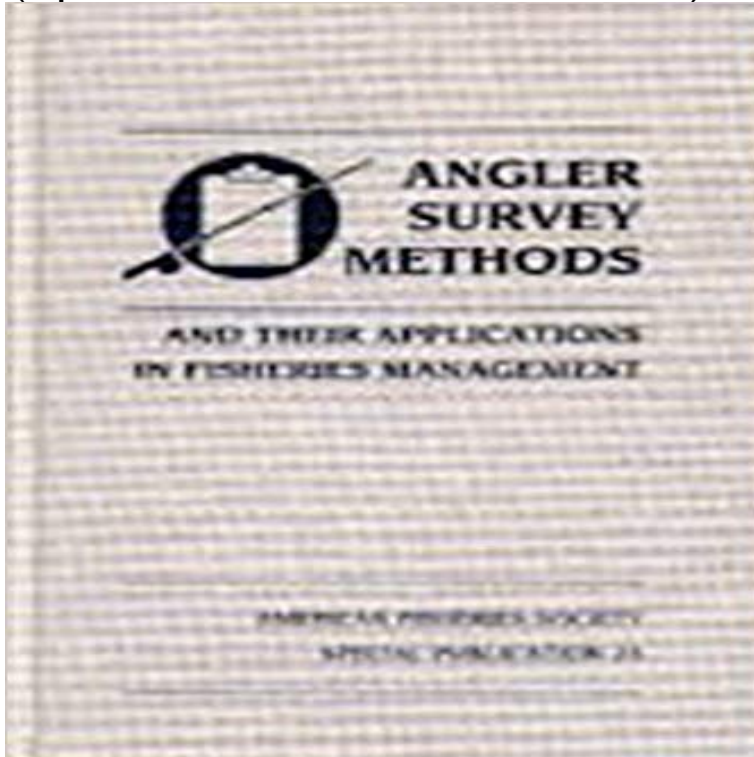


Angler Survey Methods and Their Applications in Fisheries Management (Special Publication Series : No 25)
