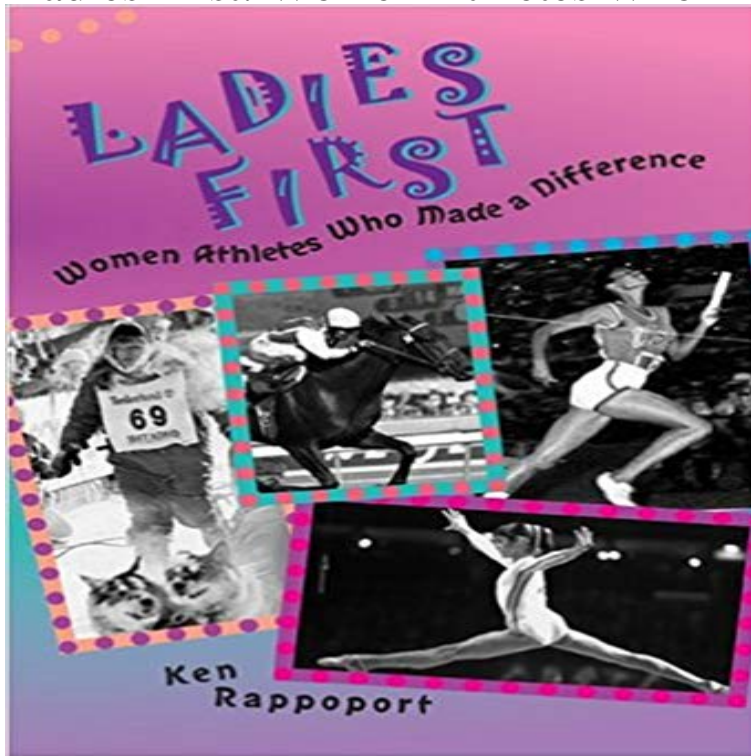


## Ladies First: Women Athletes Who Made A Difference
