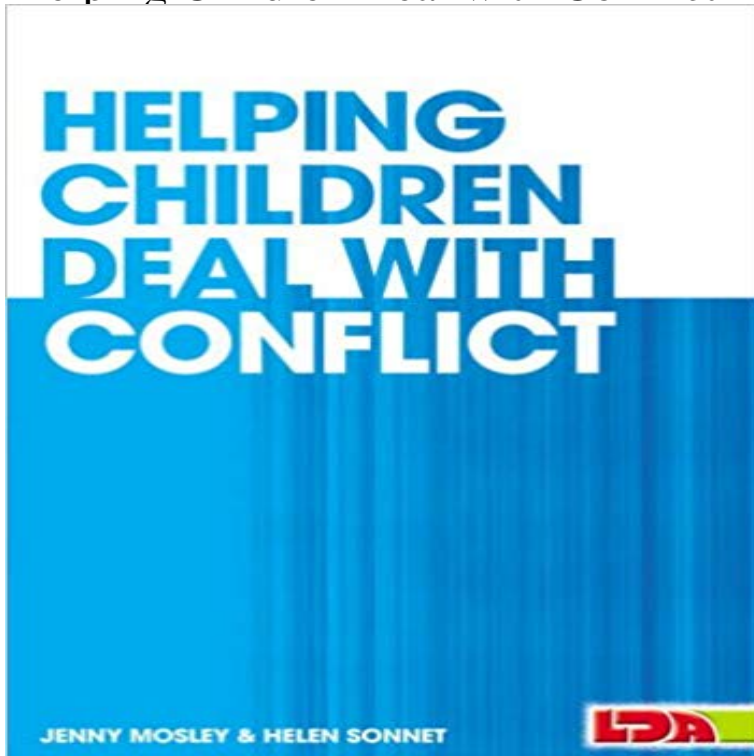


Helping Children Deal with Conflict
