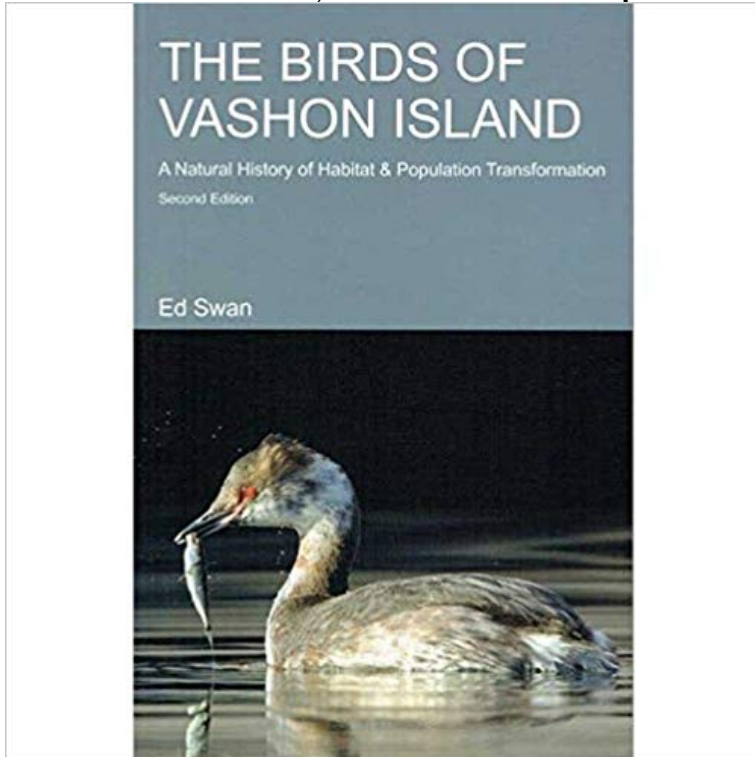


The Birds of Vashon Island: A Natural History of Habitat and Population Transformation, 1850-2005 -Paperback
